REGISTRATION RULES

Here's the packet outlining all the fun Houseparty activities that you've been so anxiously awaiting. You'll find lots of things you'll want to participate in and it's so difficult to wait until that "opening date" to get your registration forms to the post office.

Maybe you dropped your forms in a mailbox on the opening date for a previous Houseparty or Convention only to find that it didn't get postmarked until the next day – or even a few days later – and you missed out on the workshop you were really looking forward to. Or maybe opening day was the day you woke up to a flooded basement or an urgent call from your daughter who's late for work asking if you could care for your grandchild who can't go to school because he has a tummy ache, and mailing your theme luncheon registration suddenly was the furthest thing from your mind.

We've heard your frustration, so now you no longer have to wait to mail your registration forms. We still have an "opening date," but any registrations that are postmarked on that date or before will be considered firstday postmarks. For instance, if the opening date was February 1st, it wouldn't matter if you mailed your registration forms on January 5th, 10th, 17th or February 1st. They would all be considered firstday postmarks as though they were all mailed on February 1st.

So relax, enjoy looking through your packet, fill out your forms for your favorite activities before you forget, and drop them off at the post office at your convenience – as long as it's on or before the opening date if you want the best chance of getting your first choices.

And don't waste your money on overnight or other expedited postage rates. We use the postmark date, not the day we receive it. Please contact the NAME Office if you have any questions.
