### **FS1 – Rustic Workshop** *by Michelle Faleshock* *Class fee \$97*

This rustic structure can be your “In-the-Woods” house, workshop or “In-Town” bakery or shoppe. Also, included is the base it will sit on and a sign that may hang outside if it is a business.

## **FS2 – Tiny Tudor Cottage**

*Class fee   **\$92***

Paint, stain and assemble this quaint Tudor Cottage with bedroom loft and completely landscape the grounds to create a lovely guest house, storybook home or romantic getaway cottage. A combination of metal miniatures, wooden furniture and accessories complete the charming scene (included).

***Minimum Skill Level: Intermediate 1/144" scale***



**FS3 – Teapot Garden Shed** *by Abby Vukovich*  
*Class fee \$77*

The Teapot Garden Shed is a 1/2" structure set on a picture frame base. Students will assemble a pretty shed "retreat," make a tree, a fence, a teapot garden, a bench or swing for the front porch. The bench in the picture will be somewhat different and can be made into a swing. Dolls and furniture not included.

## **F1 – Marionette Stage** *by Dan Zerkel*

*Class fee*   **\$42**

Build a 4 color marionette stage designed to look like a play castle. Perfect for displaying your collection of marionettes. The stage is 7-1/2" tall x 6-1/4" wide. The stage opening is 3" x 2-3/4" with bars above the opening to hold the marionettes and backdrop in place.

## **F2 – Little Girl's Dress** *by Donna Eckel*

*Class fee*    **\$47**

A pretty little girl's dress with attached slip will be made from either pink, green, or white batiste trimmed in lace and decorated with silk ribbon bows and a rose. We will also be making a hanger for the dress or you are welcome to bring a doll so that the dress can be made directly on a 3 inch doll.

**F3 – A Stylish Place for Everything** *by Jane Elgass*  
*Class fee \$24*

You will construct the shelving unit using spacers to add the shelves and dividers. You will spray paint the shelving unit, stain it and add the top at home. For the baskets, you have enough needlepoint canvas to make 6 and they will be constructed using a template and scrapbook paper you provide. The paper adds strength and enhances appearance. Full completion of all baskets will be done at home.

**F4—Lets Play Dress-Up!** *by Jean Ellsworth*  
*Class fee \$52*

You will complete 2 sets of hats, boas and purses so the child in your house will have a set to share with her friend. No children in your dollhouse.....ladies will love them, too. Select from 20+ colors of straw, ribbons and trim. Learn tips for working with straw, learn to make ribbon roses, ribbon techniques and much more. ***Minimum Skill Level: Beginner***

**F5 – 1/4" Gnome Home** *by Sue Herber*  
*Class fee \$107*

Did you drool over the charming book about the imaginative underground life of a community of woodland gnomes? This little 2 story underground house has an entry on the top floor, down the stairs from the grassy roof and through a decorative door. Once inside, the walls and ceiling are covered with planks. In one corner is a well for fresh water and embossed gnome heads on the covered ceiling. Down the ladder is the main living room area with a large decorative stove, cupboard beds and dresser built in the wall. Join the FUN!

**F6 - “Red Robin Reality”—A 1/4” Birdhouse Shop**  
*by Karen Benson* *Class fee \$57*

Red Robin Reality is a 1/4” (1:48) scale Birdhouse Shop designed to fit within a baseball size acrylic display case (included in kit). Finished piece will be 3”x3”x3”. You should completely finish the piece during the workshop time. The kit includes all the items pictured—including the baker’s dozen of birdhouses. This is a great kit for someone new to 1/4” scale as it involves lots of basic techniques. We will wallpaper the interior and exterior walls, build a simple bench, apply foliage to a preformed tree, paint the hay bales and make birdseed bags and birdhouse from printed graphics.

## **F7—What Kid Doesn't Like Cupcakes & Ice Cream!?**

What kid doesn't like cupcakes and ice cream? We'll be making quarter scale cupcakes and dishes for Neapolitan ice cream with chocolate sauce and whipped cream. We'll be practicing different techniques for creating fancy frosted cupcakes, including adding a chocolate drizzle, colorful sprinkles and even small mints or citrus slices. You'll have time in class to complete about a dozen cupcakes and several bowls of ice cream, but you'll have materials provided to make more when you get back home!

**F8 – Living Fairy Garden** *by Linda Farris*

Create a living fairy garden using a miniature “faux” gourd house, “faux” mushrooms, a patio set and real plants. Add a log path, a fairy and miscellaneous accessories. You may want to bring some items to add to your garden. Pots may vary.

## **S1 – Garden Arrangement I** *by Charrita Teague*

*Class fee \$44*

Enjoy making this harmonic garden arrangement. Learn painting techniques, flower construction and arranging, techniques in weathering and/or bug affected plant damage. This technique can be applied to this arrangement or just use later. The Garden Arrangement will look great outside your playhouse, in a conservatory, in a garden of any scene or you can enjoy it alone.

## **S2 – Child's Easel and Chalk Board** *by Roberta Haley* *Class fee \$52*

In this workshop you will be building a child's easel with a chalk board on one side and a roll of paper on the other side. The paper will be moveable so you can draw or paint on your paper and then change it whenever you wish. If you don't wish to create your own picture one will be provided for you. There is also a shelf between the two sides to hold your miniature art supplies provided. Counting beads on the top of the easel will have your miniature children doing math in no time.

### **S3 – Cookies and Milk** *by Carolyn Eiche*

Class fee **\$60**

Part of my playtime memories are a large glass of milk and warm cookies straight out of Mom's oven. In this class you will learn the basics for creating 6 different kinds of cookies and how to use polymer resins for making milk. We will create chocolate chip, peanut butter, gingerbread, Oreo, sugar and butter cookies along with a pitcher and glasses of milk. Each student will receive a variety of plates, cookie sheets, jars, tins and trays to display your cookie creations any way you wish.

**S4 – Playhouse Bed** *by Gwen Campbell*  
*Class fee \$47*

If your child's playhouse is in the backyard she will need a garden bower bed for sleepovers. This child's bed, with a crayon look rainbow canopy, carries out the Noah's ark theme on the front of the playhouse. Students will build the bed, paint it, and use fabric to drape the canopy. Bed fits the 1" scale playhouse for Thursday evening's workshop.

## **S5 – Marionettes** *by Dan Zerkel*

Let's put on a play! In this case, with marionettes that you choose to make: a King and Queen, or Mr. and Mrs. Santa. You will learn to sculpt the heads from air dry clay, paint the bodies and heads and string the marionettes . Royal colors, bunka and gold trim for the Royals. The Clauses will be dressed in traditional red with white trim. Mrs. S is wearing an apron because she has been busy making cookies.

**S6 – 1930 Patsy Doll** *by Winifred Holloway*

You will dress a 3" porcelain Patsy Doll in 1930 style of pastel organdy. You will have a choice of colors; pink, blue, green or lilac. Her hat will match her dress. Patsy's panties, socks and slip are of lace. You will make leather shoes for her tiny feet. The finish touches will be silk slash and rosettes for her dress and hat.

Have you wanted to learn to more about silver metal clay? Now is your chance. In this class, students will learn the basic techniques for working with metal clay. Additionally, you will learn about various ways to embellish your metal clay items and will be able to choose the ones you want to make your pieces uniquely yours. Bring a magnifying glass and light if needed. All other materials and supplies are provided.
