So, grab your cuppa, sit back, and enjoy the ride!!

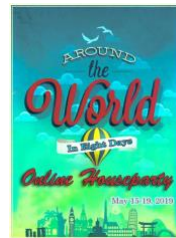

Online Houseparty Terminology

These definitions are provided to explain NAME Online Houseparty Terminology and the activities available.



Auction

An auction of special items donated to NAME with all proceeds going to NAME. This may be held through NAME's online auction site or other venue such as 32 Auctions. See <http://nameonlinehouseparty.org> for information on when and how to participate.

Banquet / Meal Functions

Meal functions at Online Houseparties are 'virtual' and optional. See the schedule for day and times. Registrants have the option to sign up for tables of 10. There will be a host/hostess assigned to each table.

Centerpiece

All tables feature a centerpiece at each meal functions. These are miniature scenes, depicting the Convention theme, which various NAME members have created. For this Online Houseparty our centerpieces are virtual. Instructions for creating your own centerpiece will be given. There will be a drawing for 10 kits to be given away from the registered participants list of names. For this houseparty there will also be kits for sale on the website.

Exhibit Room

A Houseparty highlight is a wonderful display of miniatures that have been shared by the registrants through a photo gallery on the Online Houseparty website.

Garage Sale

This is a typical garage sale of miniature items donated to NAME. There will be bargains galore through a photo gallery on the Online Houseparty website. This may be held in an offsite location such as 32 Auctions. Instructions will be given on the Online Houseparty Web page.

Gold Star Volunteers

This is a program that allows attendees to volunteer their time to assist the various committees at the Convention. Volunteers who work for at least two hours at the Convention receive a Gold Star Volunteer pin. See the registration packet for information on what type of volunteers are needed for the Online Houseparty event and how to sign up. If you have computer and online chat room experience your skills could help others navigate the Online Houseparty site.

Home Improvement Seminars

Home Improvements Seminars are FREE to all Houseparty attendees. They are held throughout the Houseparty. Presenters volunteer their time and expertise and the seminars are always interesting and educational. The times and subjects will be listed in the final schedule found in the packet.

Hospitality Room

A virtual room (a webpage) is setup for the registrants to visit. Puzzles and games may be available for download, prizes may be given out. Chats may be scheduled for those wanting real time interactions with other attendees

Hostess/Host

Registrants sign up ahead of time to be a hostess or host at meal functions. They have specific duties such as introducing the guests to each other, making the guests feel welcome, etc. It is best to have attended a NAME Houseparty at least once before you sign up to be a Hostess/Host.

Houseparty Helpers

Houseparty Helpers are donated items valued at \$50 or more. Raffle tickets are sold and the proceeds will be used to defray Houseparty expenses. Houseparty Helpers are displayed ahead of time on the Houseparty website. Tickets are purchased through the NAME office prior to the Houseparty. One ticket is chosen from each container and that person wins that Helper. Winners are announced on Saturday on the Online Houseparty website.

Roundtable Workshops

Instructors will offer kits for sale through the Online Houseparty website. Kits are sold for \$5 or less to complete the workshop, which should take 30 minutes or less. The kits will be ordered directly from the seller and buyer is responsible for payment and shipping costs. This transaction is between the RT seller and the buyer.

Roundtable Workshops - "Mega"

Instructors will offer kits for sale through the Online Houseparty website. Kits are sold for \$10 or less and the workshop should take two hours or less to complete. The kits will be ordered directly from the seller and buyer is responsible for payment and shipping costs. This transaction is between the RT seller and the buyer.

Sales Room

Selected dealers with a variety of miniature merchandise at various prices and these dealers have virtual tables on the Online Houseparty website. Many dealers will offer special items on their virtual sales table that are specifically designed for the Online Houseparty. Other may offer special discounts or free shipping from their website. Links to the dealers' websites are posted on the webpage.

Souvenirs

These are specially made gifts for each Houseparty registrant. Souvenirs are limited editions and made only for the Online Houseparty. They are included in your souvenir box. Registrants are requested not to open souvenirs until the specified date and time to add to the excitement.

Steering Committee Gifts

These are gifts that are made or provided by the generosity of the HP/Convention Steering Committee and usually are designed to complement the theme of the event or to go along with the souvenirs.

Theme Luncheons

These are virtual luncheons at which an artisan will present a demonstration or lecture on a specific subject. These presentations will be included with your special gift. The number of gifts is limited and you must pre-register and pay for the event to receive these gifts. A list of these Luncheons is included in your registration packet. Your gift and presentation will be mailed to you prior to the Houseparty.

TNP

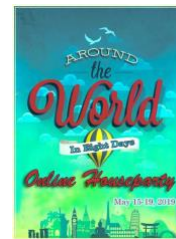
Stands for Thursday Night Project. This is a special workshop/event that is put on by the Steering Committee. It is usually held on Thursday evening and is usually a project that relates to the theme of the HP/Convention. You must pre register and pay for this event ahead of time. Details and forms are in the registration packet. The cost of the supplies for these projects are usually donated, or at wholesale cost. Steering Committee members and artists often donate surprise gifts to attendees. It is a fun evening event as well as being a fund raiser for NAME or the HP/Convention.

Workshops

Workshops are posted on the Online Houseparty website before the Houseparty and registrants may sign up for these workshops before the event. Workshop instructors will ship these kits to registrants prior to the Online Houseparty. The number of participants is limited, and you must pre-register for these workshops. A fee is charged for Registered Workshops. See the workshop lists for the cost of the class/kit and shipping costs. If there are any openings remaining in these workshops, they will be filled at the Houseparty. They will be shipped after the Online HP.



Advanced Table Seating



We know that many of you are 'traveling' together or plan to meet friends from all over the world at the Houseparty and would like to sit together for the virtual meal functions. It is our goal to accommodate your seating preferences. When you fill out this form, please be sure that everyone you list agrees to this arrangement and that no one is part of another seating group. **Please send only one form per group.** The maximum number is 10 per table; however you do not have to fill a complete table. **One of the 10 spaces will be designated for the hostess.** You may choose your own table hostess by having the hostess complete the Table Hostess Form and by indicating that she would like to be the hostess for your group. Otherwise, a hostess will be provided for each table. If you have no seating preference, please indicate that on this form.

Basic Toolbox List



Here is a list of items you may want to include in your basic toolbox. This is only a suggested list - there may be additional items you want to add or some you may not want to include at all. However, these are generally the things an instructor will expect you to have with you. If you need specific tools beyond this list, your instructor should let you know in advance. Your toolbox will evolve over time and reflect your personality as you make your miniature creations.

Xacto knife with #11 blades	Sandpaper (medium/fine)	Small cutting mat
Small notebook and pencils	Needle nose pliers	Paint brushes- various sizes & styles
2 pair scissors (paper & fabric)	Masking tape	Small spring clamps
12" and 6" cork-backed rulers	Tacky Glue	Fine point tweezers
Toothpicks	Emery Boards	Glue spreader/old hotel keycards

Below are additional supplies that you may find are helpful to have:

You may wish to bring a work light and extension cord as hotel lighting isn't always the best for Miniaturizing.

Bring a camera to take pictures of instructor samples and special setups/tools used.

BASIC SKILLS

These are considered the basic skills necessary for a productive, enjoyable workshop experience:

1. Use basic tools confidently
2. Cut accurately with an Xacto knife
3. Read rulers and mark lengths accurately
4. Have knowledge of basic glues and how to apply them
5. Know how to paint smoothly

When asked to list the skills needed beyond the basic ones, most instructors reply that they would be more than prepared to teach whatever their students do not know how to do. What they would like students to have are open minds and a willingness to learn.



Convention Protocol and Cancellation Form

Neither the National Association of Miniature Enthusiasts, its officers, members, agents or assignees, nor the Convention Steering committee, jointly or severally, shall be responsible for loss of goods, merchandise displays or other accouterments which may result from fire, flood, theft, vandalism, Acts of God or any action which may occur before, during or after the Houseparty. Participants are hereby advised that the National Association of Miniature Enthusiasts and its designated authorities do not and will not carry insurance to cover damage or loss which may be sustained by participants, participants' personnel and/or guests.

We invite you to apply to sell a Mega Roundtable Workshop at the NAME 2019 Online Houseparty “Around the World in 8 Days”. A Mega Roundtable Workshop is a “make & take” project which can be completed in 2 hours or less and costs no more than \$10.00. Each kit is to include an Instruction Sheet with assembly instructions, a photograph of the completed kit and the instructor’s name, address, phone number and e-mail address for student follow-up if needed.

There will be a sale period for all Mega Roundtable kits which will be listed on the Online Houseparty website for purchase. Those wishing to purchase a Mega Roundtable kit will contact you directly and the transaction will be between you and the purchaser, without any NAME involvement or liability. The prototype which you sent with the application will be photographed and placed on the Online HP web page. If you prefer, you may take your own photograph and send that to the roundtable chair as a standard photo file (e.g., .jpg or .png) for use on the website.

Important to remember:

- **Mega Roundtable instructor must be registered for the Online Houseparty to sell Mega Roundtables at the HP. Cancellation voids acceptance as a Mega Roundtable instructor/seller**
- **The maximum cost of any Mega Roundtable shall not exceed \$10.00. Shipping from the US within the US should be no more than \$4.00 for shipping and handling for 1 kit plus \$1.00 for each additional kit. Actual international shipping costs may vary greatly and are at the discretion of the instructor.**
- **A mega roundtable teacher may have one item offered in multiple scales or two separate but related items in one scale only.**

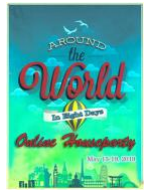

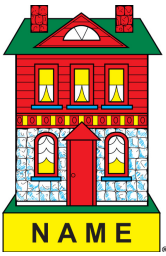
