After visiting this spectacular miniature collection, a buffet dinner will be served at the beautiful and historic Washington Opera House, just a few steps from the museum. This Opera House is the oldest of its kind still operating in the U.S., with live performances still being held. This two-story brick building was constructed in 1898, on the same spot as the old opera house, originally built in 1851, but burnt down in January of 1898. You can see no time was lost rebuilding this important community building, which was rebuilt at a cost of \$24,000. (https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Washington Opera House!)






