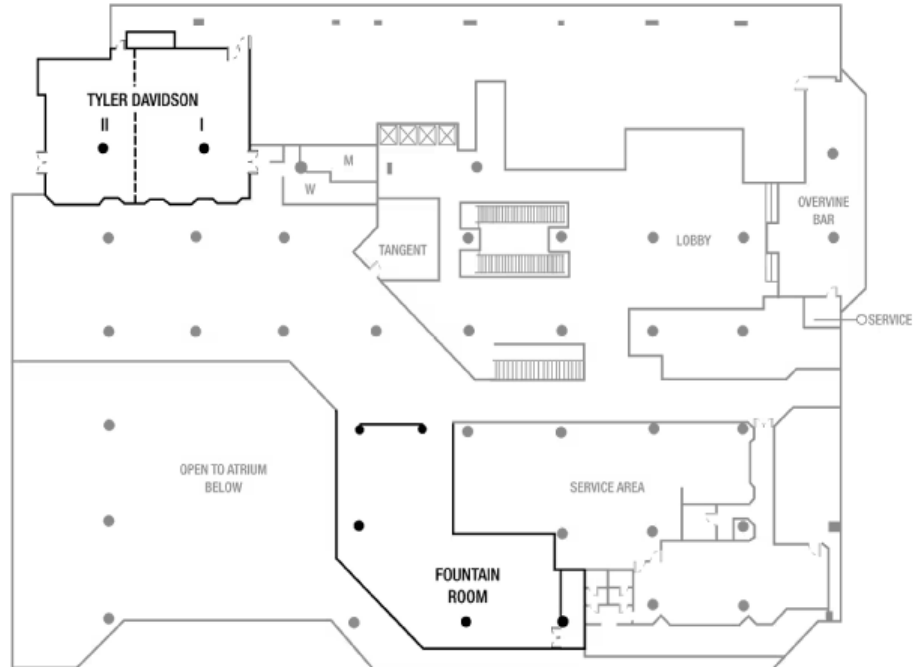

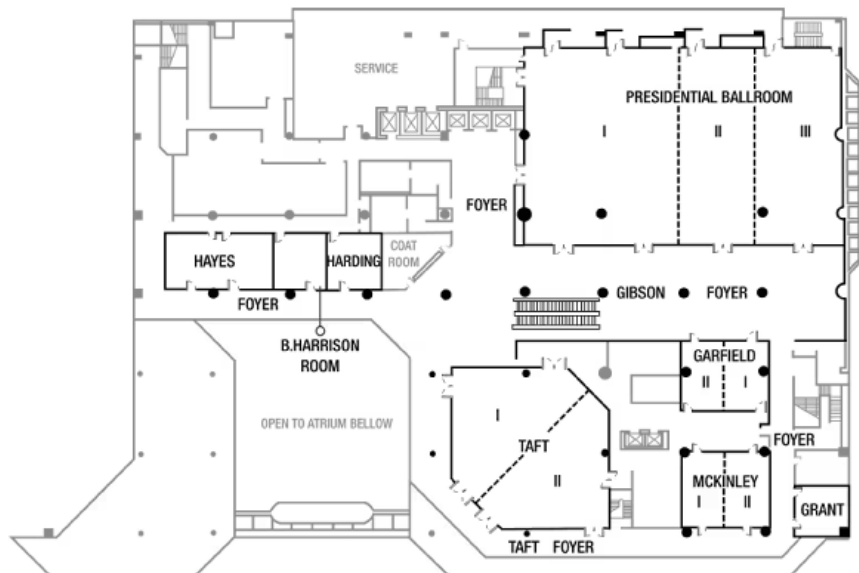
Hotel Floor Plans

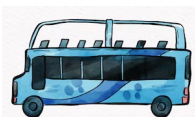


2025 Souvenir Artisans
