LAKESHORE MINIATURE MAKERS RETREAT JUNE 12 – 15, 2025

<u>What is it?</u> A weekend get-together of up to 30 miniaturists, that begins on a Thursday afternoon and concludes after lunch on Sunday. No classes, no gifts, and no centerpieces. This will just be a fun, relaxing time to work on unfinished miniature projects or other artistic endeavors, meet old friends, and make some new ones.

<u>Cost – per person:</u> Based on three nights lodging, plus nine meals. Please note the minimal increase that was incorporated into the fees for next year's retreat. This is due to the generosity of an "angel" that donated money to cover a large portion of the cost of renting the Assembly Room for three days.

Single Occupancy: \$485.00 Double Occupancy: \$435.00 Commuters – Meals Only: \$215.00

Full payment is due by <u>January 31, 2025.</u> Complete this form, along with a \$50.00 deposit (unless you have already paid the deposit at the 2024 retreat), to reserve your spot.

90 days or more prior to arrival date 100% of deposit less \$50.00 processing fee

61-89 days prior 80% of total deposit

60 days or less to arrival date No refund

<u>Silent Auction</u>: We will again be conducting a silent auction. You keep the proceeds. It will conclude on Saturday evening, after dinner, around 7 PM. All items must be registered and a bid sheet attached. If there are missing pieces, it must be noted on the bid sheet. Bring cash, as no checks or credit cards, will be accepted.
