In Memoriam: Joanne Martin – 1938-2023

As a young girl, Joanne Urspruch Martin was ambitious and creative, knowing she could make the world a more beautiful place, and not be content to stay in the background. As a young woman she worked for a seamstress sewing curtains, and then started her own wedding business, making dresses, cakes, and flower arrangements. She was a volunteer teacher at the juvenile detention center. She was a Girl Scout herself, and then became a troop leader for many years, continuing long after her own girls had moved on. In the 1980s she joined with other miniaturist friends who wanted a permanent home for their art, and they incorporated in 1989 as the Miniature Museum of Greater St. Louis. Joanne was elected President in June, 1992 and became a driving force in the purchase, preservation and maintenance of exhibits and in 2001 opened the current Museum building. In 2014, they doubled the size of the Museum, adding a second level of exhibits. Joanne continued as President of the Miniature Museum until her death on November 2, 2023, three days after celebrating her 85th birthday.



One of her many miniature specialties was crafting amazing tiny flowers, most notably, roses. She generously shared her skills through classes, and gifted bouquets to friends, the Museum gift shop and even to nurses at doctor appointments. Her basement workshop included hundreds of various paper punches, to create them – all meticulously catalogued.

She was also known at Christmas for her labors baking 2-3 dozen TYPES of cookies, which she would share with neighbors, friends, and, gratefully, her miniature family at the Museum.

Her niece, Stephanie Lewis summed up Joanne well – "Joanne was a brilliant mind, a creative spirit, a quick wit, a fighter, a defender of underdogs, a friend to the friendless. The world was fortunate to be graced with her presence for the blink of time we had her around."

We couldn't agree more.
