TH1 – Flickering Jack-O-Lantern in a Window by Tammy Witthaus Class Fee \$62

Students will create this flickering Jack-o-Lantern in a window by assembling the window bay, embellishing & landscaping the oval band box, and creating hat & spider. Fire LEDs will be used to create the candle flame in the pumpkin. Wiring of those LEDs will be taught in class. Students should bring small sharp scissors, xacto knife, cutting pad, ruler, tweezers, tacky glue, your favorite super glue, and Yes glue. Window structure 3" x 1-3/4" x 3-1/2" and Jack-o-Lantern on box 1-1/2" x 1" x 2"



TH5 – Designer Handbag & Wallet by Melissa Nobbs Class Fee: \$97

Students will create a Birkin style handbag and matching wallet set in 1:12 scale. The workshop will include precut leather for both the handbag and wallet. Our focus will be constructing the bag and wallet, including hand stitching, gluing leather, and adding hardware to the final pieces. If time permits, students will be able to make an additional bag or wallet. 1-1/4" x 1-3/4"

TH6 – Wicker Tray with Wine & Cheese by Joan Purcell Class Fee: \$57


Students will do a basic weave on a small wooden base. There will be a small bit of assembly on some accessories for the tray. A bottle of wine and a set of Chrysonbon wine glasses will be included. These may vary slightly. 1-1/2L x 1W x 1H

TH7 – Weave a Miniature Rug by Mary Martin Class Fee: \$97

You will receive two looms to create one 5" x 7" or one 3" x 5" rug. You will also receive two shuttles, reed, & instruction booklet. Choose the yarn you would like to weave into your rug. Learn to warp your loom & secure the warp ends. Use heddle sticks to add tension to the warp. Wind weft yarn to load the shuttle. Learn how to create the shed used to weave the weft. Use the reed to assure weft placement. Learn about techniques to secure your woven project and remove it from the loom. Enjoy weaving miniature rugs! 3"x5" or 5"x7"

F1 – ¼" Wine Cellar Tasting Room with Veranda by Ginger Landon-Siegel Class Fee: \$97

Create a fully stocked tasting room with an outside veranda to bring back memories of a special moment. Students are expected to complete the inside of the tasting room lit with a soft bulb light and the outside veranda complete with decorative railing and landscaping. The tasting room includes 3 counters you will make and fill with dimensionally shaped rows of wine bottles, cheese and crackers trays and other accent pieces. The extended half round veranda includes potted plants, wood urns, a welcome sign, 2 tables for guests to stand or they can relax on the elongated bench. Complete instructions for finishing all the accessory pieces including the Wine Cellar banner and wine related signs are included with the class. Barrel is $3-1/2w \times 2-1/4D \times 2-3/8H$. Veranda is 1-3/4D.

F2 – A Miniature Grocery Run by Atlas Faeryn Class Fee: \$62

This workshop will be a technique-based class where you work with polymer clay and soft pastels to create a miniature bag of groceries to add to your kitchen. We will create a loaf of bread, colored with soft pastels, a dozen eggs, several fruits and veggies, and of course every grocery store run needs to have a sweet treat, so we will finish up with some chocolate chip cookies. I have specifically chosen these mini groceries to teach you skills that will allow you to work with polymer clay to make a broad array of minis on your own in the future.

F3 – UV Resin Ready Mold Class by Ruth Stewart Class Fee: \$223

This is a really fun class to learn how to use and work with UV resin. You will learn how to mix colors and use syringes with needles for fine application. Your kit will come with 6 alcohol inks, needles, syringes, cups for mixing, UV resin, UV rechargeable flashlight and 6 wonderful molds! This class comes with the jello mold, gummy bear mold, rose mold, Christmas lights mold, Christmas sucker mold and jelly bean mold. If you already have some of these in UV resin ready then I am happy to substitute, just email me before class. Also, this class will come with 1:12 molds. If you want 1:48 or 1:24 I have 3 you can get in those scales, the Christmas sucker, rose and jello molds. Come and have some fun!

F5 – Log Cabin Retreat 1:48 Scale by Karen Benson Class Fee: \$176

The Log Cabin Retreat is a spacious log cabin structure that will be built in two sections – the 1st Floor main living space and the 2nd Floor Bedroom sleeping area. Interior dimensions of each floor are 6-3/4" wide and 3-1/2" deep. The workshop includes 6 Mega LEDs incorporated into the structure (3 each floor hidden in ceiling) with AAA battery pack hidden in base. All kit pieces for the workshop will be pre-stained golden oak. The workshop includes everything shown in the photos and the main log cabin sections can be completed in the workshop time allowed. Overall size is 8" W x 5" D x 7-1/2" H.

After learning a few steps, the student will be able to make a length of lace and also some ornaments for miniature Christmas tree. Please bring a magnifier if you need to use one.
