NAME Workshop Instructor Application Instructions

Deadline-Must receive by: November 3, 2025

NAME invites you to apply to teach a workshop at our National Convention or Regional Houseparty. To be considered, you must be a current NAME member. If you are interested, please complete the following application, and mail it, along with the requested photos, to the NAME Office at the address below. **Please note that if you are applying as a dealer you must plan on fully registering for the convention if accepted as a Workshop Instructor.**

Please note the following important information:

1. Postmark deadlines for applications are posted in the Miniature Gazette and on the NAME website: www.miniatures.org. Accurate and timely applications (that conform to the rules) are vital to the decision-making process.
2. The Office will register up to the maximum number of students you indicate on your application. There is no minimum. It is expected that classes will be taught regardless of the number of students that register.
3. *Photographs or computer-generated pictures:* remember, this is your one opportunity to sell your workshop, so make it count! Be sure your photographs are sharp and show your project clearly. All photos should be on a single page. Some members of the selection committee may not be familiar with your work. Please do not use samples or line drawings.
4. The Cost of Materials/Kit is the amount you will receive for each student registered for your workshop. The published price of your workshop will be that amount plus a \$17 administrative fee.
5. At the **Convention**, Pre-Convention Workshops are held on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday (1, 2 or all 3 days) and are 8 hours each day. ****Please note at the La Quinta, CA Convention Wednesday's workshops will be from 8am-3:45 so registrants can attend the Gala.** Registered Workshops are held on Thursday and Friday mornings and are typically 3½ to 4 hours long. At **Houseparties**, Pre-Convention Workshops are held on Thursday (8 hours) and Registered Workshops are Friday and Saturday mornings (3½ to 4 hours).
6. Please be specific in your description. If your project is accepted, this is the description that will appear in the registration packet, so you will want to make it appealing to prospective students as well as the selection committee.
7. **The NAME logo is trademarked and, as such, may not be used in any products without prior written approval by the NAME Board of directors. Use of other corporate logos is subject to their restrictions.**
8. If your Workshop is selected as part of the Convention/Houseparty, you will be sent a VIP registration form with your acceptance letter. You must be registered for the Convention/Houseparty to present your Workshop.
8. Upon acceptance, you will receive a workshop agreement and a \$20 fee will be assessed to all instructors to help defray costs associated with providing workshops at the Houseparty or Convention.

Please email the application, and pictures to kim@miniatures.org. There is no fee to apply electronically. Your application and picture page will be uploaded to a secure cloud location for the selection committee to review.

If you choose to mail your application and pictures, please include a \$5 processing fee. You may either send a check or money order to the address below or pay via PayPal to: name@miniatures.org Be sure to include description of payment with check or PayPal. For CC users mailing in their app, please fill out the form below. Your application and picture page will be scanned and uploaded to the cloud.
