

Cut out all pieces. Fold and glue the flaps of the cover to the back using Yes glue or a glue stick.. Let dry. Fold the panels as followed. Fold each **second** page divider as a mountain fold over the edge of a ruler. Make a sharp crease with your fingernail. Then fold each mountain fold over to the next mountain fold. This will create the valley fold and you can line up the pages perfect. Sharpen all creases and glue pages back to back. Fold book cover along spine and glue the dried inside pages to the inside of the cover. Let the book dry with the pages fanned open. If you want to keep the book closed, clamp the pages together and rub a **tiny** bit of yes glue between your fingers and along the edge of the pages. The book still opens if you want.
